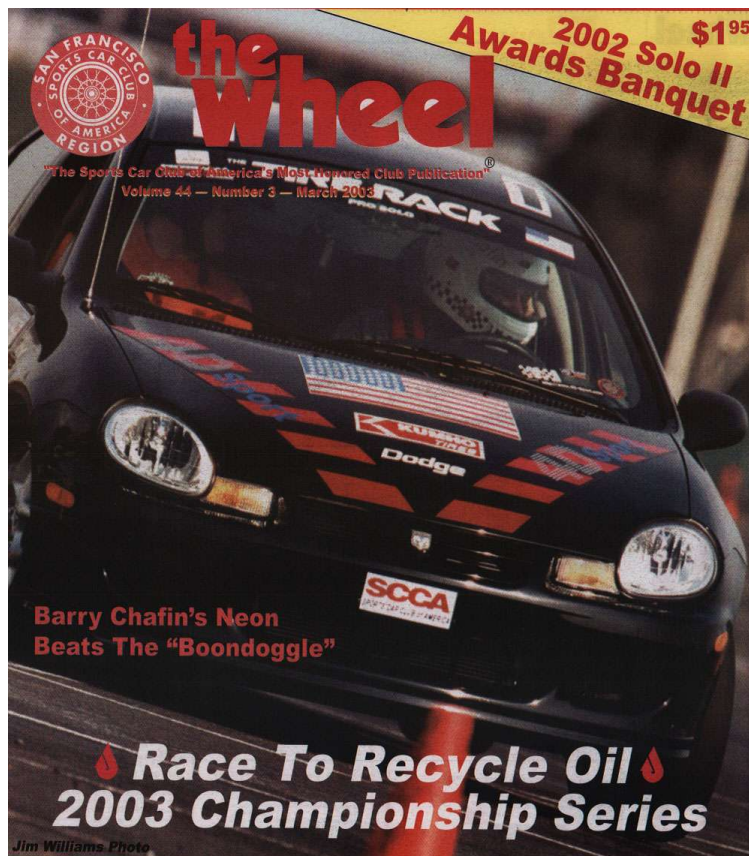

### *About Our Motorsports Venue*

The [Sports Car Club of America's \(SCCA's\) Solo2](#) program, also known as autocross, is a contest of driving skill. We run against the clock (i.e. “solo”) on short courses that emphasize car handling and agility rather than speed or power. The courses are constructed on parking lots and inactive airstrips of traffic cones defining a “mini” road-course. These courses consist of straight stretches (although few and short), slaloms, chicanes, sweepers and hair pin turns.

Runs are timed to 1/1000th of a second and knocking a cone down means a penalty of 2 seconds added to that time. While speeds are no greater than those normally encountered in legal highway driving, the combination of concentration and car feedback creates an adrenaline pumping experience.
